# 7B4. Assessment form – Final draft of paper (for instructor to complete)

#### 90-100 points

The paper is well-organized at the paragraph level. Sentences are smooth and carefully crafted. There are virtually no errors in punctuation, spelling, grammar or usage. Words are chosen with precision. The paper sounds like it was written by a human being for another human being. The paper is tight, not wordy. The content is first-rate in all regards.

# 80-89 points

The paper is well-organized, but the paragraph structure is sometimes disjointed or unclear. The paper may have a few awkward passages and some errors in punctuation, spelling, grammar or usage. At times, the language may be too general and it may lack the precision of a better paper. None of these concerns, however, is glaring or highly distracting. The content is correct, but perhaps not complete or relevant.

## 70-79 points

The paper is basically well-organized, though some paragraphs may be disunified or misplaced. Generally though, the paper shows that the writer has followed a logical plan. The writing is competent but wordy general or imprecise. Sentences may sometimes be constructed awkwardly, but their meaning is clear. Grammar, punctuation and spelling are not highly distracting, but there may be some errors. The content may be inadequate or contain errors.

## <69 points

The paper is poorly organized. Some parts may be so confused that their meaning is not clear. Words may imprecise, inappropriate, incorrect or vague. These errors distract the reader. The content has errors and is inadequate.
